#### **Evaluation and Assessment**

The school follows a Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation system. To ensure uniformity in performance and to inculcate the habit of lifelong learning in pupils, Class activities for all the subjects and for English LSRW (Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing) activities will conducted as per the norms of the CBSE board and students are assessed periodically along with two Summative Examinations for CBSE board going students and as per state Govt matric board examination will be conducted, and for other classes three Summative Examinations will be conducted . All results are recorded in the student's report card and parents are informed about their ward's progress throughout the year. This enables them to interact with the ward's teacher, so that all can work in unison for the betterment of the student.

#### **Tests & Examinations**

Besides Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation system and two Semester Examinations organized by the school, Students are also prepared for the following External Examinations:

- 1. Grade X & XII Examination for CBSE Board conducted by the CBSE, New Delhi
- 2. Std X ,XI, XII Examination for Matric board conducted by the Department of School Education, Tamil Nadu.

#### **CODE OF CONDUCTS**

#### **STUDENTS:**

- ✓ Students are expected to make sure that they come to school regularly in a proper washed and ironed uniform with clean socks, polished shoes and also with the ID Card.
- ✓ Students must maintain perfect silence during the assembly and in the school premises.
- $\checkmark$  When leaving the class for break and lunch time students must go in an orderly manner.
- ✓ No students should write /scribble on any wall in the school premises.
- ✓ Any damage done to the school property especially Computers will be rectified by the one who made it.
- ✓ Students should not wear gold ornaments or expensive watches. Electronic gadgets are strictly prohibited. If this is violated the teachers will keep these items and will return only when his/her parents come and collect them.

- ✓ The school is not responsible for the loss of any goods. The students should take care of their belongings.
- ✓ Students should obey the teachers, School Pupil Representative (SPR) and other students on duty.
- ✓ No gift of any sort, collectively or by individuals to the teachers are allowed without the permission of the principal.
- ✓ Our campus language is English. All must use campus language in the school premises.
- ✓ Students should at all times show respect and reverence to the school authorities and the staff. They should be gentle and polite in their approach to others.
- ✓ It is compulsory to be present on all occasions such as Reopening day, Last working day, School day, Children's day and Teacher's day.
- ✓ Irregular attendance, lack of punctuality, habitual idleness, disobedience or disrespect to the staff, bad moral influences on other children and any act of indiscipline justify dismissal of such students from the school.
- ✓ Late comers will get a late attendance entry in the diary. Once they come in, they are not expected to leave school until the school gets over.
- ✓ If there is any emergency, a student may be sent home along with the parent. They can come and collect the child. In such a case, the parent must fill the leave log and give back to the administration.
- ✓ Under no circumstances, the students will be accompanied by a stranger to school.
- ✓ Students should obtain prior permission of the class teacher for not attending the classes If prior permission is not obtained due to unavoidable circumstances an application for leave should be sent to the class teacher the same day or latest by next day.
- ✓ Application for leave on medical grounds is to be supported by an authentic medical certificate.
- ✓ Pupils should always remember that the name of the school depends on each one's good behavior and that they are real ambassadors of the school. So their behavior inside and outside should be excellent and praise worthy.

- ✓ No child is allowed to take tuition from any teacher employed by this school or outside the school without the prior permission.
- $\checkmark$  The school authorities will not be responsible for any incident or accident beyond their control.
- ✓ Parents must assist their Children in preparing for the Monthly /Semester projects and Assignments
- ✓ Every child must be in time for assembly as well as for the classes.

#### Rules for leave / Absence ( students)

- ❖ Prior permission should be obtained before taking any leave.

  If leave is taken due to illness, the school office is to be informed by telephone or letter before 9.15 a.m.
- Students returning to school after suffering from an infectious or contagious disease are to produce a doctor's certificate permitting them to do so.
- Students are responsible for making up all work missed.
- ❖ If absent for two or more consecutive days for medical reasons or any other reason, the parent should meet the principal or vice principal in person, preferably with the medical certificate.
- ❖ It is compulsory for the students to complete 80% of their attendance in the year to make them eligible to appear for their final examination.
- Student suffering from the following diseases must observe the prescribed period of quarantine before returning to the class:
- 1. Chicken pox-Till complete falling of the scabs.
- 2. Cholera Till the child is completely well.
- 3. Measles Two weeks after the rash disappears.
- 4. Mumps Until swelling has gone.
- 5. Whooping cough Six weeks.
- 6. Viral fever 3-5 days.

#### **Boarding at MAMGS**

Boarding at MAMGS is 'a home away from home'. We have boarding houses for both boys and girls who want to stay in the boarding house. As a day boarding and residential school, we actively encourage our children to adopt a healthy lifestyle by providing a well-balanced and nutritious diet. A room accommodates 16 students where each one is provided with a bed, working-table and a cupboard. Morning drink before morning study hour, soup during the interval in the forenoon, milk and snacks in the evening are provided daily in addition to breakfast, lunch and dinner. A resident teacher looks after the welfare of the students. She/He plays the role of a friend; philosopher and guide as far as the wards are concerned. She/He keeps in touch with the wards and helps them to solve their academic and personal problems.

#### **Rules for Visits & Outing**

- ❖ Parents/Guardians / authorized persons may visit their ward on the fourth Saturday / Sunday between 9.00 am to 1.00 pm.
- Students are permitted to go out along with their parents or guardians on the evening of second Friday and return on Sunday evening before 08.00PM
- During emergency time, parents may visit their children in the school visitor's room during weekdays with prior permission.
- Parents are requested to inform the school if they wish to take their child out of school on any occasion.
- If you take your children home for a weekend, please ensure, they complete their homework before they return to school.
